The Lions Clubs are recognized for helping the visual and hearing impaired through countless local efforts, as well as through their international One Sight Program, Lions World Sight Day, and collecting eyeglasses for distribution in developing countries year-round.

World-wide, there are approximately 45,000 clubs in 201 countries with a membership of 1.3 million members. The Momence Chapter has been active since 1945 and currently has a diverse membership of 20 members ranging in ages from 30 up to 90.

In addition, Lions make a strong commitment to young people through youth outreach programs. Lions also work to improve the environment, build homes for the disabled, support diabetes education, conduct hearing programs and, through their foundation provides disaster relief around the world.

- ☐ Additional pages, as necessary, to answer essay questions on page 4 of this packet
- ☐ A current resume highlighting work and volunteer experiences
- ☐ One sealed and initialed letter of reference from a faculty member, employer, or a representative of a service organization you are currently affiliated with.

Please note that applicants are responsible for submitting all required materials. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed, nor will applicants be contacted to request missing materials.

2. Be active in Community Service.

3. Applicants may be interviewed by the selection committee for further consideration. The Lions Club Scholarship Committee will contact the applicant if an interview is necessary to arrange a meeting time.
